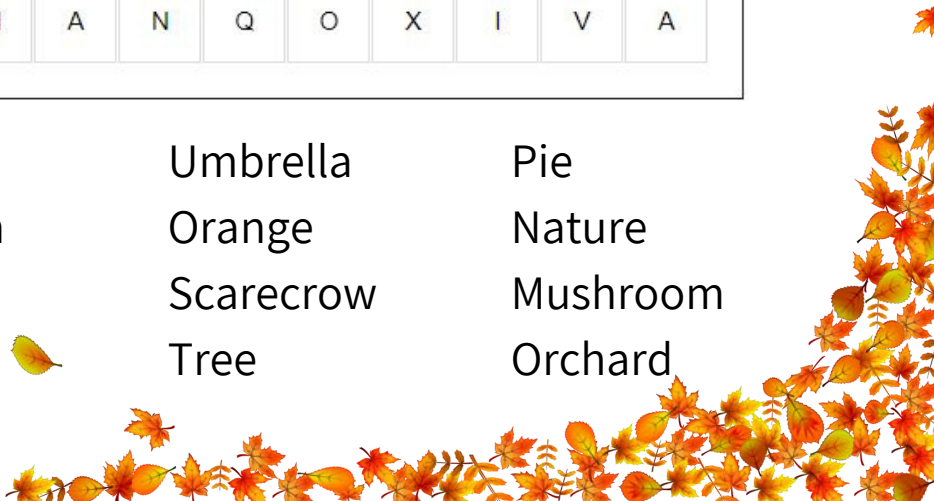

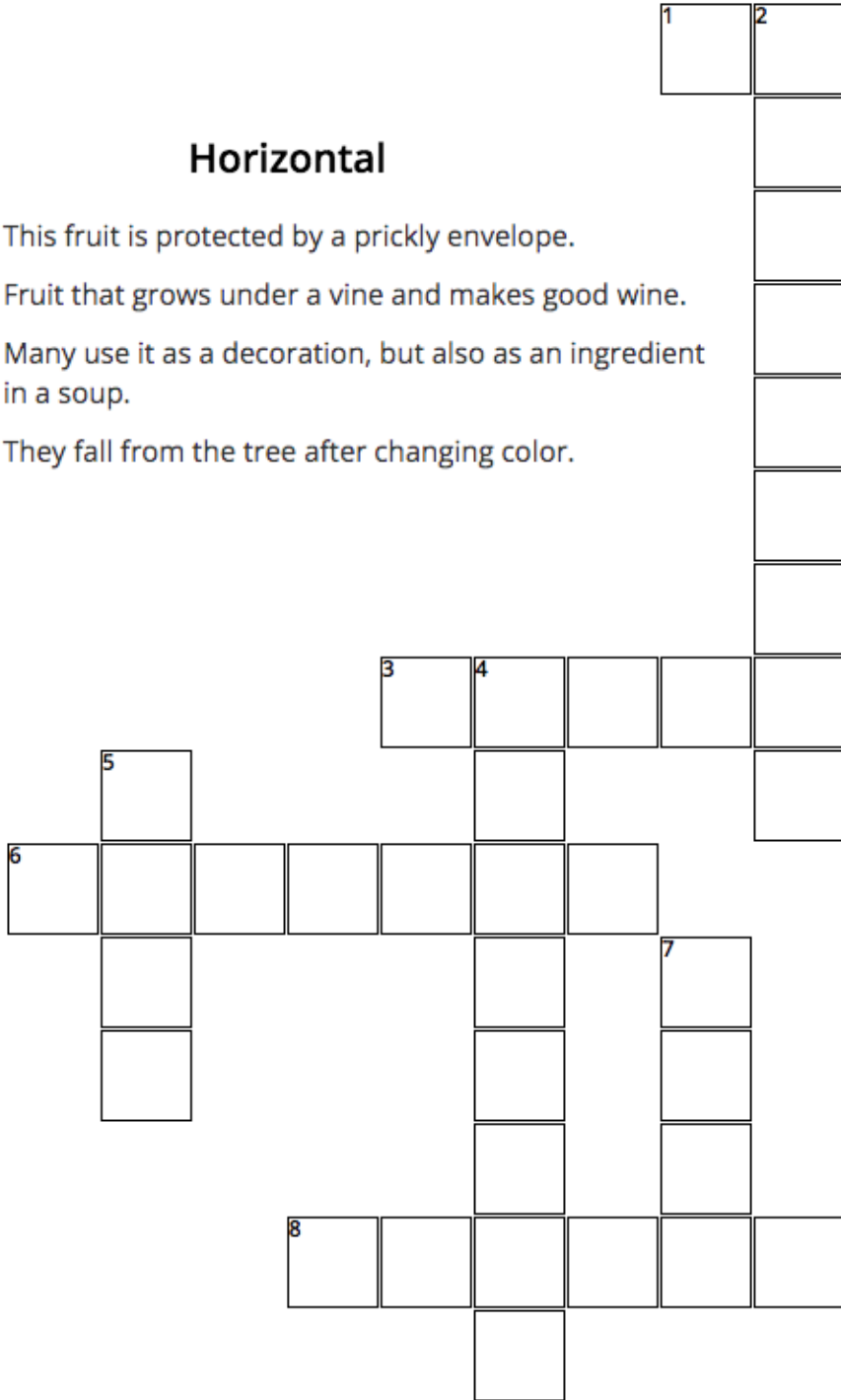

8. They fall from the tree after changing color.

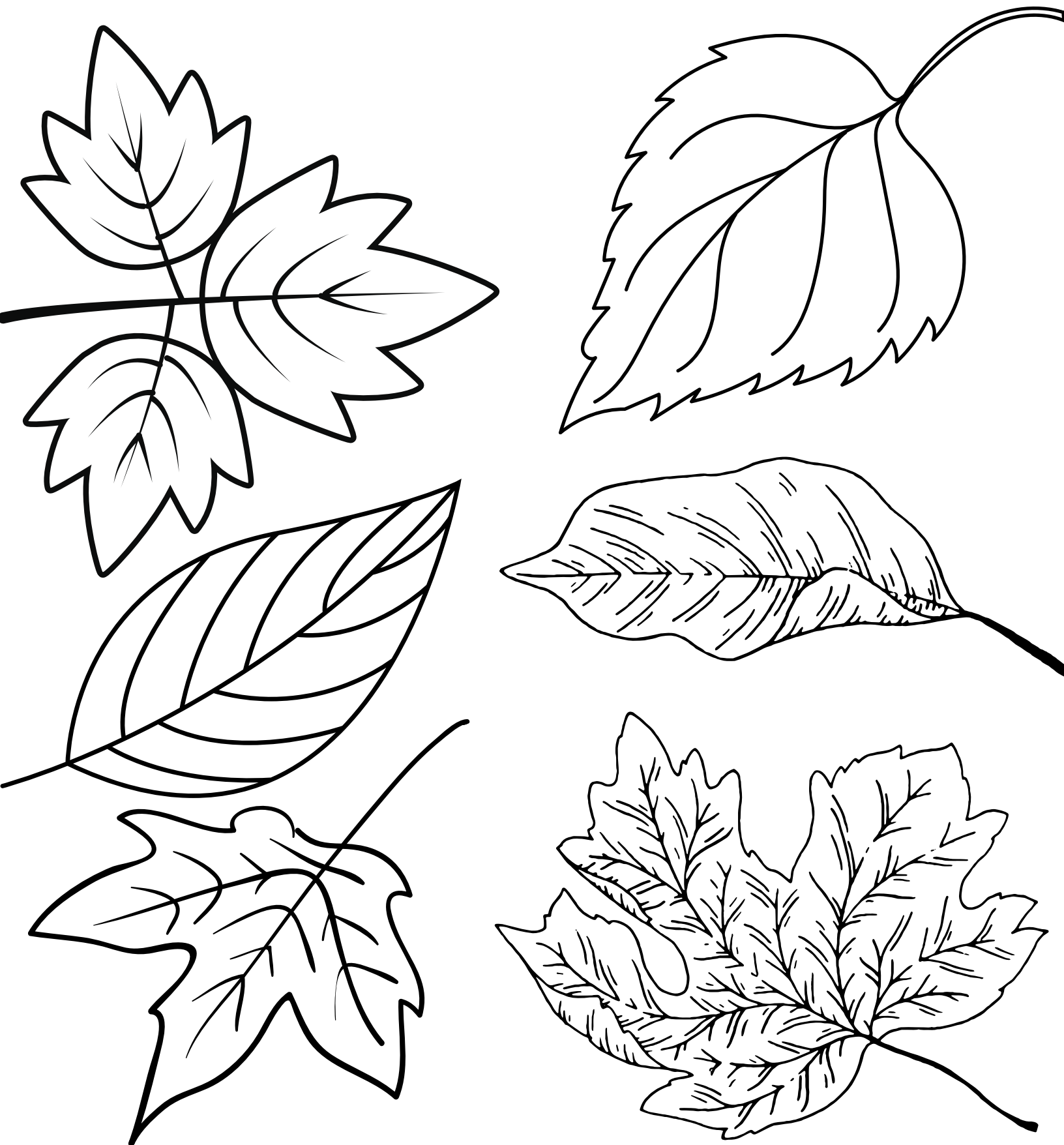


## Vertical

# TALK AND REMINISCENCE

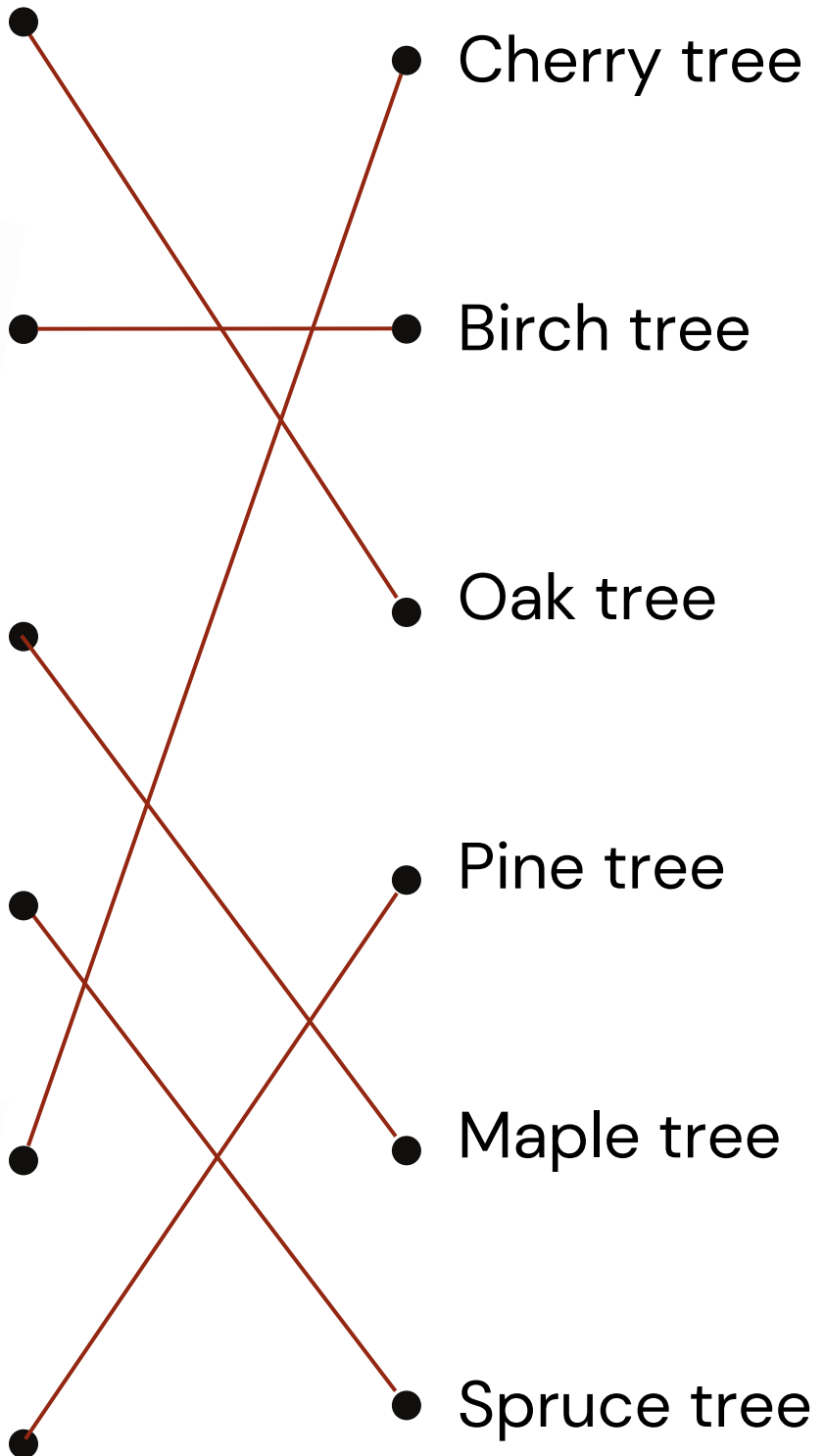
## Theme: Fall Activities!

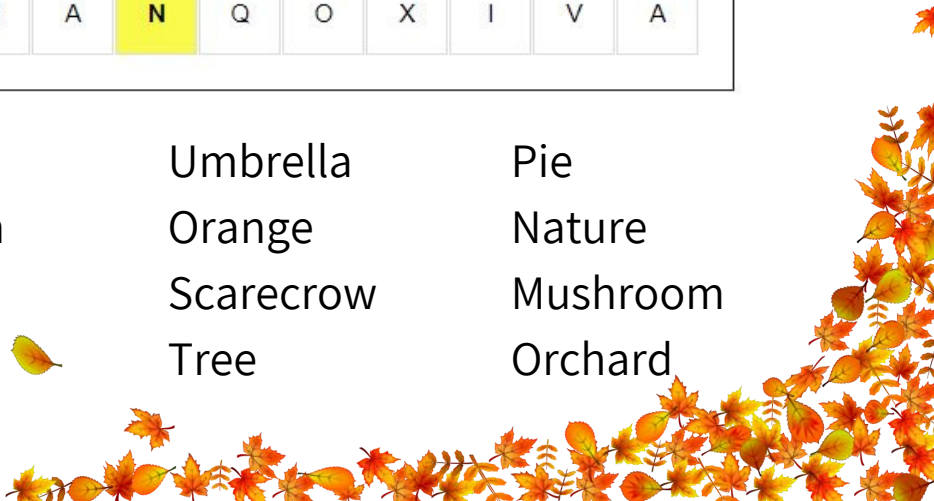
